PORTACE PORTAC

Volunteers/Coaches Needed!

- Commitments
 - Complete application requirements (see later slide)
 - ▷ February May: Help out with Optional Preseason Practices
 - May/June: 2 practices per week (1 weekend & 1 weekday)
 - June/July: Approximately 2 games & 1 weekend practice per week
- Rookie Division: PHS softball players and coaches
- All other divisions will need 1-2 head coaches and 2-3 assistant coaches per team
- We need volunteers for PYS to be successful!



Head Coach Responsibilities

- Evenly divide the players in their division among the teams of that division with the other head coaches
- Communicate with their team parents & players as well as with PYS with PYS preferred communication methods
- Schedule practices and inform PYS and team parents/players of any changes to the practice schedule
- Schedule games with other teams while trying to create a balanced schedule (frequency of games, home/away, etc.)

PORTA CA

Head Coach Responsibilities (cont.)

- Organize practices and delegate responsibilities to other assistant coaches and parent helpers
- Decide what players will play what positions during games while trying to balance playing time
- Promote good sportsmanship among all players, parents, and coaches
- Try to continually improve as a coach while maintaining a fun, competitive, and positive environment



Assistant Coach Responsibilities

- Instruct players with the help of the head coach and other assistant coaches
- Work with the head coach to effectively run a practice
- Run stations during practices and before games
- Assist the head coach in other areas as needed



Parent Helper Responsibilities

- Throw batting practice during practice and before games
- Shag hit/fly balls as needed
- Keep the dugout and field clean during practices
- Help rotate players between stations during practices
- Help players with equipment, especially helping the catchers put on and take off catching gear
- Assist where needed at the discretion of the head coach or an assistant coach
- Parent helpers can be very useful, but should try not to instruct players on the specific mechanics of hitting, throwing, pitching, etc., unless the head coach instructs them to. Instruction should be left up to the coaching staff. Additionally, parent helpers can help before a game, but should not be in the dugout during the game unless the team is short on coaches.


Registration Fee Breakdown

COVID-19 Safety Precautions: Optional Preseason Practices (Indoor Activities) (Subject to Change)

- Masks required at all times (over mouth and nose)
- Maintain social distancing of six feet (6')
- No sharing of food & beverages (drinking fountains discouraged)
 Players should bring their own water bottle
- Parents/guardians must stay on side of gym by bleachers
 - Maintain social distancing and wear masks
 - Encouraged to wait in vehicles during practice times
- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer prior to entering and as needed

COVID-19 Safety Precautions: Outdoor Events (from 2020 summer season) (Subject to Change)

- Approved volunteers/players in field, dugout, and bleacher areas only (bleachers closed to spectators/parents)
- No eating of food or spitting/chewing of seeds
- No attendance if sick or exposed to sick person
- Dugouts only used for games and not practices
- Limited restroom availability
- Limited sharing of catching gear
- Game balls switched every half inning
- No high fives or non game-play contact

COVID-19 Safety Precautions: Outdoor Events (from 2020 summer season) (Subject to Change)



- Social distancing of six feet (6') when possible
- No huddles, conferences, or celebrations in the field
- No sharing of water/sports drinks
- Use of hand sanitizer throughout games/practices
- Spectators/parents/fans must provide their own chairs
- Parents not allowed to watch practices (must wait in vehicle)

2021 Registration Process (All Online - One Form to Complete)



- 1. Visit <u>www.portageyouthsoftball.org/registration</u>.
- 2. Read through information on "2021 Registration Home" page.
- 3. Go to "Athlete Registration" page or click "Register Now".
- 4. Find your "Promo Code" prior to registering (if applicable).
 - Check your email or contact PYS directly for your code.
 - See next slide for more information on "Promo Codes".
- 5. Enter athlete information (and "Promo Code" if applicable).
- 6. Enter Parent/Guardian contact information.
- 7. Enter Emergency Contact information.
- 8. Enter Medical Information (i.e. allergies, fainting, etc.)
- 9. Read through all agreements and PYS policies.
- 10. Sign your signature to agree to agreements.
- 11. Enter payment information and submit registration.

2021 Registration Process: Registration Credit Promo Codes



You likely have a "Promo Code" for 2021 Registration if you:

- Registered, paid, and did not play in 2020 and you requested a registration credit
 - ▷ \$30 or \$100 credit awarded based on amount paid in 2020
- Played on the 2020 10U Team or 16/18U Team and originally registered and paid for the 10U Division or 16/18U Division
 \$50 (10U) or \$75 (16/18U) credit awarded due to lack of games
- Enter the "Promo Code" on the registration form to receive the discount. We can't apply the discount after registration. Codes are good for one use only. Do not share your code with others.

2021 Registration Process: Outstanding Balance/Fees



You may have an Outstanding Balance if you:

- Were moved to a higher division in 2020
 Owe the difference in registration fees
- Registered and played but did not pay during registration
 - Amount due varies by age division and number of games played

Ways to pay the Outstanding Balance:

- Via PayPal invoice that was sent on February 17, 2021
 If paying via invoice, fee may appear on registration form for several
 - days after payment until removed from registration system
- Via 2021 registration if player legal name matches name on file
- Must be paid prior to start of 2021 summer season


